Summer Reading Tips:

- Partner Read! Ask your child to take turns reading a page at a time with you.
- Storytelling on the Go! While riding in the car, take turns adding to a familiar story, or make up a new one of your own.
- Stop and Think! Encourage your child to tell what is happening in the story every few pages.
- One More Time with Feeling...! To improve fluency, have your child read with expression. Experiment with the 'voices' of the characters.
- Make Connections! Help your child connect stories to their own experiences, other books, or their background knowledge.
- READ, READ, and READ some more!
